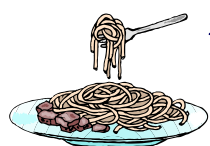


Preschoolers, Pajamas, & Popcorn . . .
oh, my!

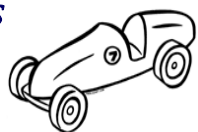

Spaghetti Meal for Missions and Race Car Derby



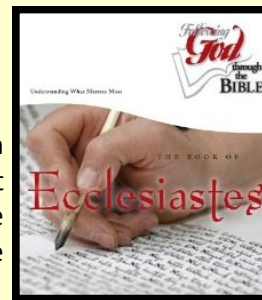
