Our study of **ROMANS** has begun and will continue through the middle of February, 2011. Often called the "Constitution of our Faith," Romans is "a sweeping panorama of God's redemptive plan from sin to salvation to sanctification. To understand the Christian life, the believer in Jesus Christ must understand the truths of the book of Romans" (Dr. David Jeremiah). **DISCIPLESHIP OPPORTUNITIES COMING SOON!**

On **Wednesday, February 3rd**, *Women of Himfluence* will begin an 8-week "Precept upon Precept" study of the book of Joshua. This inductive, practical study will increase your faith in the God who is WITH you, will encourage you to press on, and will embolden and encourage you to embrace the promised-land living God has purchased for us in Christ. Discussion groups will allow participants to share insights gleaned from personal study, and Haven will teach the large-group session. The study meets from 9:15am—11:15am in the Fellowship Hall, and at 5:45—7:00 in the Media Center. No-cost childcare is available. A registration fee of \$20 (payable at the first session) includes the student book from Precept Ministries International.
