Thursday, September 14 – Historic Mabry Mill! We are headed just across the NC/VA line to visit **Mabry Mill** in Meadows of Dan, VA. The mill is perhaps the most iconic structure on the entire Blue Ridge Parkway. This gristmill has for more than a century produced grits, cornmeal and buckwheat flour. That tradition continues even today. In addition to the mill, there are demonstrations of Appalachian crafts and traditions on the property. **The Mabry Mill Restaurant** offers country style meals that include breakfast (served all day), BBQ, traditional chicken pot pie and their famous blackberry cobbler. The gift shop features Virginia made crafts as well as the gristmill products to take home to enjoy.

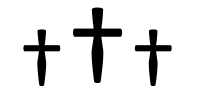
