"The Price of Freedom Museum" Tuesday, February 27 @ 11:15 a.m.

"The Price of Freedom Museum" is an American war memorial, dedicated to the men and women of the United States who paid the ultimate Price of Freedom with their very lives, in service to our great country. The museum started as a private collection of uniforms and military memories preserved by Bob Mault. After 40 years of collecting, and hours of hard work, the museum is now housed in the Old Patterson School in Rowan County. The current collection has expanded to over 5,000 artifacts and includes extremely rare uniforms, covering all of the armed services of the United States. This display of 20th century American military history represents the efforts and sacrifices of individuals who have served and given their very lives for the freedoms we enjoy today.
