Mission Trip to Casper, Wyoming June 22-29

We will partner with Boyd Avenue Baptist Church in building a multipurpose facility next to their existing building that will allow them to increase their ministries within the community. We will fly to Casper and stay at the church which has sleeping, shower and kitchen facilities. Total cost would be about +/- \$675 per person.
(total cost depends on final airfare but should not fluctuate much)

After three listening sessions last Fall, conducting an online survey and offering a written survey asking for feedback about our ministries with children and what we could be doing next, the Search Committee charged with looking at how we serve children and their families shared the results with the Deacon Council on Sunday, February 10. While valuing the role of volunteers and parents, about 90% of members responding and participating would like to see the church call a full-time staff minister to work with children (birth through grade six) and their parents. A new staff member would allow us to shore up the gaps we have in our current ministry with children and help First Baptist begin preparing for the new Kannapolis that is on the way through the extensive and long-range renovations and development plans currently unfolding in our city. We have a number of children God has given our church now, about 300 kids involved in soccer every Fall and enormous potential with the new city we are building. The Deacon Council, by unanimous vote, directed the Search Committee to begin looking for a qualified, capable candidate immediately. Please join with our Deacons and Search Committee in asking God to lead our church to the right person and to begin preparing that person to serve our church and community. Exciting times are on the way as we look to expand, invest in and intensify our ministries to children in Kannapolis and our church family!
