Sr. Spotlight on Healthy Living - From Our Friends, the HONEY BEES!!

We will gather in the Assembly Room on Thursday, February 28 at 10:00am for a fascinatingly "sweet" presentation from Jerry & Tanya Sumerel who love sharing with people the God given goodness of nature. Jerry is a certified NC State Beekeeper and an authorized dealer by the NC Dept. of Agriculture & Consumer Services to sell bees. He stays abreast with the latest information pertaining to honey bees by continuing education, attending regional/state conventions and participating in workshops. He is an active participant of the Cabarrus County Beekeepers Association and has served as Secretary. Jerry & Tanya volunteer at local fairs, apiary events, host bee farm tours, and even mentor aspiring beekeepers. They have won multiple awards for Best Comb Honey, Best Dark Honey, and Best Creamed Honey. Honeysuckle Hill Bee Farm products include: award winning honey, unfiltered and straight from the honeycomb, creamed honey – a blue ribbon winner in 7 flavors (*Natural, Blackberry, Ceylon Cinnamon, Lemon, Orange, Peach and Raspberry*), handmade beeswax candles, local bee pollen, cinnamon from Sri Lanka and the bees themselves! NOTE: There is no charge for this program, but you'll want to bring your wallets, check books or credit card to purchase some sweet healthy treats!!

While valuing the role of volunteers and parents, about 90% of members responding and participating would like to see the church call a full-time staff minister to work with children (birth through grade six) and their parents. A new staff member would allow us to shore up the gaps we have in our current ministry with children and help First Baptist begin preparing for the new Kannapolis that is on the way through the extensive and long-range renovations and development plans currently unfolding in our city. We have a number of children God has given our church now, about 300 kids involved in soccer every Fall and enormous potential with the new city we are building. The Deacon Council, by unanimous vote, directed the Search Committee to begin looking for a qualified, capable candidate immediately. Please join with our Deacons and Search Committee in asking God to lead our church to the right person and to begin preparing that person to serve our church and community. Exciting times are on the way as we look to expand, invest in and intensify our ministries to children in Kannapolis and our church family!
