OIAM Projects you can sign up for:

1. Midway Cleanup followed by a Prayer Walk around Loop Road

3. Esther's Heart– paint porch, stain deck, flower bed work
4. Tear down of outside storage building in Landis
5. Finish tearing down sheetrock in garage in Kannapolis
6. Paint front porch & ramp with non-skid paint in Kannapolis
7. Replace 2 storm doors in Kannapolis
8. Fix board on front porch, rebuild ramp, porch repair in Kannapolis
9. Appreciation of our Kannapolis Police Officers with baked goods and notes/letters. You can drop these items off here at the church between April 26-30. The Children will be delivering these to the Police Department on May 1st. (Candice Carter is heading this up if you have any questions on the notes or baked goods)

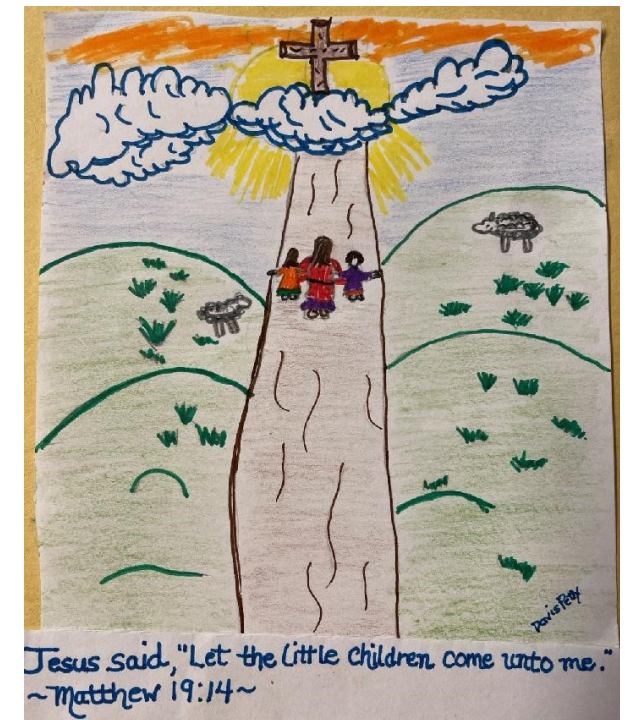
