1. If you are sick or feel sick at all, do NOT come to any FBCK related activities. We are still offering our worship live online each Sunday at 10:55am on Facebook live and youtube.com/FirstBaptistKannapolis. Remote worship may be an option you wish to use.
2. If you test positive, please contact those with whom you may have had close contact. The church office can help you with phone numbers or email addresses.
3. Remember to give people space. We often like to hug and greet each other but some people may not prefer that kind of contact at this time. Be conscious of your distancing and aware of keeping adequate space between yourself and others.
4. Be aware of COVID-19 symptoms and stay home if you experience them. It is always good to check out those symptoms with your doctor or another healthcare provider.
5. Wash and sanitize your hands often. Sanitizer and soap are abundantly available at our building.
6. The CDC's recent guidance recommends wearing a mask in indoor settings. If you feel more comfortable with a mask and wish to wear one, please do so. We respect your decision to do so and will be happy to supply you with one if you need it.
