Senior Adult trip to The Eastern Cabarrus Historical Society Museum & Lunch at Mama T's, Thursday, April 25

Did you know that there's a museum in Mt. Pleasant, NC? The Eastern Cabarrus Historical Society Museum is housed in the old NC College/Mt. Pleasant Collegiate Institute. Today this old historic building is filled with artifacts, photographs and documents displayed in 30 rooms. Each room is themed and filled with items donated by local families and individuals. Visitors will enjoy seeing old farm tools, vintage clothing and accessories as well as war items from the Civil War through the Iraq War. The building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Our tour guide and host at the museum will be our own Bill Lutrick! In addition to the museum tour we will enjoy lunch in historic Gold Hill, at the newly opened Mama T's.

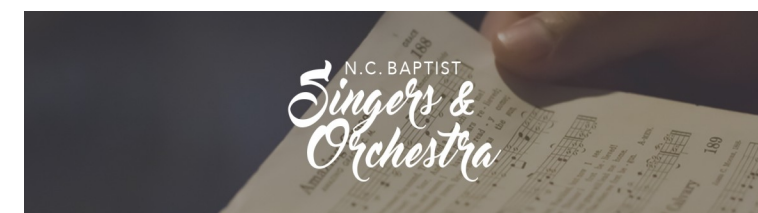
