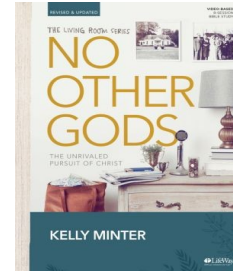


Communal Lunch

Frank will be looking to put together a team and trip shortly after 2020 begins. Hurricane relief is a great way to make a huge difference without traveling too far from home.

As you begin to think about your plans for 2020, maybe God is leading you to missions. We'll partner with the NC Baptist Men and the First Baptist Church of Thompson Falls, Montana June 20-27, 2020. NC Baptist volunteer teams will begin construction in early June doing framing, siding, sheetrock hanging and finishing, trim work, tile, painting, and other finish work. We look forward to taking a team of 12-15 people. We'll spend a week in a beautiful community participating in some exciting work God is doing in a small town where people are coming to know Christ for the first time.
