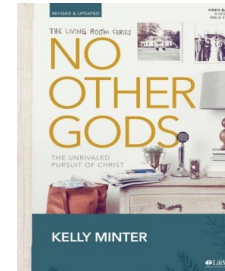




SAVE THE DATE:

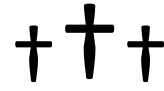
