What began as a way for Bertha Foltz to make a little extra money for Christmas soon became a family owned business producing delicious hand rolled, cut and packed Moravian cookies for the next 7 generations. Today, these traditional cookies are shipped to all 50 states and over 30 countries around the world. Currently in any given year, Mrs. Hanes produces ten million Moravian cookies—that's 60,000lbs. of flour, 40,000lbs. of molasses, 35,000lbs. of sugar and 450lbs. of ginger!! The goal is "not to be the biggest, but to be the best cookie makers in the world". On Tuesday, November 19 we will make a visit to Mrs. Hanes Moravian Cookies near Clemmons, NC. We will leave the church parking area at 9:00am. We'll stop for a BBQ lunch in Lexington before heading home. Cost for transportation is \$4.00. **Deadline to sign up is Sunday, November 17.**
